1. **One-Time Volunteer** - Great opportunity for youth groups, Sunday School classes or those looking for community service hours.
 - a. **Building Maintenance:** Replace bulbs and fixtures and fix door squeaks
 - b. **Deep Cleaning**
 - c. **Yard Work:** Trim landscaping, mow lawn, and clean brush and weeds

2. **Regular Volunteer** - We have a high need for regular volunteers who are willing to invest their time to help the community on a regular basis and making it possible for this organization to operate.
 - a. **Office Work:** Filing, appointment reminders, data & contact entry, and part-time executive assistant

 - b. **Dispensary:** We ask that our student volunteers have a regular presence at the clinic if possible. We can plan for specific duties for the volunteer to perform on a weekly or bi-weekly basis. Most regular volunteers will come in for a few hours once a week, or more during breaks from school. School comes first, and we ask that students let us know ahead of time if they are unable to volunteer at their regular times.
 1. **Technician** (a great opportunity for high school and undergrad students): Assist with inventory by unpacking medication orders, logging in medication, and documenting medication needed to be ordered; assist with medication filing; assist with filing of prescriptions or reports; assist with paperwork for manufacturer's patient assistant program, applications and renewals.

 2. **Pharmacists:** Verify medications filled by technician, patient counseling on new and refill medications, medication recommendations or reconciliation, technician duties as appropriate.

 - c. **Janitor:** clean the clinic, offices, counseling room, conference rooms, etc.

 - d. **Patient Advocate:** visit with patients in the waiting room to offer guidance and gather feedback on issues.

 - e. **Website Designer:** help keep the FCH website updated with current information

3. **Professionals**
 - a. **Eye Doctor:** qualified eye doctor willing to volunteer to serve FCH patients
